

UNIVERSITE PARIS-SACLAY
ASSISTANT PROFESSOR POSITION (MAITRE.SSE DE CONFERENCE)

Research: The person recruited will conduct research at [RITM](#), the Research Center in Economics and Management of Université Paris-Saclay. We recruit in applied economics, in any field covered by the research center: Regional and urban economics, economic policy, economics of innovation, digital economy, development and international economics, environmental economics...

This recruitment is part of a strategy deployed over the last few years to strengthen scientific production on RITM's main topics. It also aims to contribute to the [scientific and societal challenges](#) identified by the Graduate School in Economics and Management of Paris-Saclay, and to develop research synergies between the university's partners, in particular ENS Paris-Saclay, and the University of Evry.

We would like to draw candidates' attention to the total involvement in research expected by the econ department:

- A strong contribution in terms of high-level publications;
- An active participation in seminars and collective projects;
- An appetite for the valorization of research and its dissemination to audiences other than academics;
- An experience in research animation (participation in national or international research projects) and a willingness to apply for ambitious funding programs (ANR, ERC, educational innovation projects...) would be very much appreciated, as well as an ability to engage in scientific dialogue with other disciplines.

We also expect the recruited person to participate actively in the life of the Faculty and/or the University, and in their governance.

Teaching and administrative tasks: Teaching is one of the University's core missions. The person recruited will be required to teach Bachelor's and/or Master's courses, in fields that do not necessarily correspond to his/her research specialties. In particular, he/she may be required to teach undergraduate courses such as "money and finance", "market finance", "international trade" or "introduction to economics". Fluency in French is welcome, as is the ability to teach in English. The candidate will gradually take on administrative tasks for the administration of teaching and research.

Paris-Saclay offers a 20% cut in teaching load for 2 years to all newly recruited assistant professor

Location: Université Paris-Saclay has several campuses in the South of Paris, along the RER B line. The economics department and RITM are on the Sceaux campus (RER Robinson). Lectures take place either at Sceaux or on the vallée campus in Orsay (RER Orsay or Bures).
